Subject: Request of clear position of descalation regarding the crisis between Russia and Ukraine from IndustriAll Global Union and IndustriAll Europe

Dear Atle, Jorg, Luc and Michael,

on behalf of all Italian Trade Unions affiliated to IndustriAll Global Union and to IndustriAll European Trade Union, we would like to urge the need for the industrial Global and European trade union movement to take a clear position of descalation regarding the crisis between Russia and Ukraine and the necessity to build up a political and a negotiated solution that must exclude military intervention.

We are witnessing a worrying escalation of tension between the two nations with a possible involvement of USA and NATO in a conflict. As the Italian confederations, we are at the side of every country that asks for respect and inviolability of its borders, but we remind that recourse to violence has always generated sufference and made new conflicts arise.

We therefore ask IndustriAll Global Union and IndustriAll Europe to take urgent and significant position of active neutrality that helps to search for a political agreement negotiated with respect for the security and rights of populations involved, without any military intervention.

We are trustful that you will take into consideration our request.
